- Facilitate study sessions outside of class. These sessions will assist students with study skills, assist students in learning how to study course materials, and refer students to resources that will prepare them for the coursework.

Requirements to become a SI Leader:

- Earned a B+ or better in the target course
- You must have a minimum 3.0 GPA, based on coursework that may be applied to an Associate's Degree.
- You must be enrolled in at least one (non-developmental) course at CCCC during the semester when you are tutoring.
- You must have a faculty member's recommendation.
- You must be available for a personal interview and attend training sessions.

SI leaders will have the opportunity to work with students and strengthen their own knowledge in the subject matter. It is an excellent way to build your academic experience while supporting student success on campus.
